Guidelines for attending the services at St Andrew's Church at 3pm on 31st October or 1st November 2020

If you are feeling unwell or showing any of the symptoms of Covid-19 please do not attend church.

If you are self-isolating due to a possible or confirmed case of Covid-19 or have been asked to do so by NHS Track and Trace, please do not come to church.

If you are aged 70 or over, or in another group which is classed as either clinically vulnerable or clinically extremely vulnerable you are advised to make sure you are aware of the up to date Government guidance for these groups.

If you become ill after attending church, please inform the Reverend Camilla White as soon as possible (camillawhite@waitrose.com or 01483 892645).

Please observe social distancing both inside and outside the church building.

- 1. There is no restriction on numbers attending provided people can do so safely and in accordance with the other restrictions in force at the time.
- 2. Groups of up to six people from one household are permitted to sit together.
- 3. Face-coverings must be worn at all times.
- 4. There is no legal obligation to do so but it would be very helpful if you would give us your telephone number /email address. We will keep your contact details for 21 days and if required to do will pass them to NHS Test and Trace unless you tell us to the contrary. Our privacy notice is displayed in church and on our website. (standrewsgrafham.org.uk)

The QR code for NHS Test and Trace is displayed in the church porch.

- 5. When you come into church use the hand sanitiser provided at the entrance for at least 20 seconds.
- 6. Fill up the pews from the front sitting only with a member of your own household in the spaces indicated or as directed by the person on duty.
- 7. At the end of the service leave from the back of church first and move away from the door.
- 8. Remain seated as much as possible.
- 9. We will be keeping doors open throughout the service so please wear warm clothes and bring a rug or even a hot water bottle! It is acceptable to keep hats, scarves and gloves on during the service.
- 10. You might like to bring a cushion as we have removed those on the pews and also your own hand sanitiser.
